1. Establishment of Quorum, Call to Order and Introductions

2. Non-Agenda Public Comment

7. Deco Bike Stations

G. Trussell reports that the only station that would result in a parking loss in Bankers Hill, at 2700 5th Avenue, has been moved to the bus stop on the east side of the street.

8. Council Policy Review

C. DeMerville advises the committee that he is going to explore using CP200-4 to explore adding time limited parking & using CP200-7 to explore adding Pedestrian Safety enhancements around Bankers Hill.

9. Bankers Hill Angled Parking Conversions

C. DeMerville reviews the approved locations and the committee begins identifying several Phase II locations. UCPD & City staff are currently drafting letters and outreach maps for the affected blocks.

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10. Bankers Hill MCP Project

C. DeMoville shares that UCPD Staff is working with the Bankers Hill Business group to survey the business affected by the 2 to 4-hour meter conversion process.

11. Curb Repair: Community input session

The committee reviews locations around Bankers Hill that have possible parking gains through curb repair, including 2200 4th Avenue, and 500 Grape Street.
