

SDG&E PAD-MOUNTED EQUIPMENT BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT PAINTING GUIDELINES

SUMMARY: The mission of SDG&E is to improve lives and communities by building the cleanest and safest infrastructure energy company in America. SDG&E works to ensure its utility infrastructure fits within the community it serves, and we are proud to support community organizations to best identitify these opportunities through our Pad-mounted Equipment Beautification Project.

To make your efforts a success, please read and follow the procedure below.

PURPOSE: Inform external community partners (e.g. city redevelopment business or sponsored by city council) on SDG&E's standards to paint pad-mounted equipment (i.e. utility boxes) within their designated community.

PROCESS: When inquiring about painting an SDGE pad-mounted equipment, standard procedure needs to be followed as outlined below.

PRE-PAINTING PHASE

- Painting of pad-mounted equipment is restricted to main transportation corridors and business corridors.
- Painting is restricted to padmount green paint, unless a special request is made by the city development business and sponsored by city council.
- Once identified, the SDG&E equipment must be inspected by SDG&E personnel and deemed safe for the customer to move forward with painting.
- SDG&E approved designs must be artistic and not promote any Race, Color or Creed, Individual Group, Political Affiliation, or Religion.
- Only oil-based paint designed to resist moisture and corrosion can be used.
- Decals, numbers, letter on pad-mounted equipment are NOT to be covered.

READY TO PAINT

- If light rust is present on SDG&E equipment; scrub lightly with a nylon abrasive pad to remove any small surface areas on the equipment. Furthermore, wide down and remove any loose dirt and debris before painting. If sever rust is identified upon arrival, please notify the Regional Public Affairs Manager.
- Tape over the decals, numbers, hinges, and any opening that would make servicing the equipment difficult. <u>DO</u> <u>NOT PAINT OVER THE NUMBERS, DECALS, OR HINGES.</u>
 - \circ The tape should be immediately removed upon the completion of the painting.
 - Avoid painting the concrete or fiber base under the equipment as it may peel away.



Upon completion, please dispose of all cleaning and painting materials in an environmentally safe and legal manner.
