Non-agenda Public Comment Congratulations on the Greater Hillcrest MAD; the ballot initiative passed by 66% and was approved by City Council.

Review Minutes May 23, 2024 tabled

DMV Lease Initial \$25k quote for lease renewal has been lowered. Staff contacted Chris Ward's office and negotiated a 5 year lease at \$12k per year with a 5% graduation per year.

Data Mining Usage tabled

Hillcrest Normal Street Promenade SANDAG/City Update SANDAG is moving forward anticipating an August groundbreaking. We are working with the Mayor's office and City Attorney to get a contrast with the Hillcrest Community Foundation, to be managed by the HBA, selling tiles for fundraising.

400 Block University Avenue Civil and Structural Engineering RFP Update Staff extended RFP notice in the San Diego Business Journal for an additional two weeks and reached out to vetted engineering companies. From current bids, staff recommends contracting with Rick Engineering for survey work. Their bid for both survey and civil is \$23.8. KPFF's bid for structural is \$8K.

Survey work must be completed first in order to obtain final details regarding angles, spacing, etc. Final cost estimate for remaining civil and structural will depend upon the findings of the survey work. Once this step is complete, the updated structural and civil contracts will be brought before the Board for approval.

Uptown Streetcar Funding Discussion tabled

Social Media, AccessHillcrest Our contract with Explore Digital has been canceled. Access Hillcrest social media content will be done by in-house staff.
