Non-agenda public comment

Guest Melissa Lopez spoke to concerns about the parking that was recently taken away from University before Urban Moe's. More lighting may help. Anytime the Mayor repaints a street, parking lines are removed and bike lanes are put in. The first Sunday Funday of the season was twice as populated from prior years. Sidewalk repair University Avenue

(Nicholls/Earn)

Curb walls are collapsing on the 400 block, concrete work will occur. The contractor will be working under a City permit. While the crew is working on the lighting canopy, we might want to expand the work to the 300 block. Budget wise, this will require around \$10,000 more. Motion to extend curb repair to 300 block made by Ben Nicholls, Miah Earn 2nd. Unanimous.

Hillcrest Normal Street Promenade SANDAG/City update

Mayor's office assures us construction documents will be released in May following the 90 day contract assignment period. Mayor expects to perform ground breaking in July. SANDAG website now has a posted document online stating the slated operations schedule. Hillcrest's Eastern Bikeway is slated for spring 2024.

400 Block University Avenue update

HPC provided feedback on the preliminary light canopy design image: the zig-zag pattern needs to be tighter to optimize the color change effect, number of lighting strands needs to be doubled. An expedited new rendering will be requested.

Digital and social media metrics, AccessHillcrest

Access Hillcrest website has been redone to include new features like “Get in Touch,” and a map of public parking lots. Some links are broken: “Explore by Bike” and “Discover new bike routes.” Further Bus 11 social media videos discussed.
